

ERASMUS+

You have the possibility to spend one semester at a partner university in Europe.

Chalmers has established many Erasmus-agreements with partner universities.

If you go on exchange within an Erasmus-agreement you are covered by an insurance through Chalmers, you will get an Erasmus-scholarship and you do not need to pay any tuition fee at the partner university.

Important to know:

You have to be a master student at Chalmers

Important that you will take 30 credits during your first semester

The agreements are written within different subjects and the number of spots are also decided

Study in exchange programmes

Most students are eligible to apply for exchange studies. The exchange programmes enable you to study abroad as a part of your education. Taking part in a student exchange means that you spend a semester or two at a university in another country. The credits which are achieved during the exchange may be recognized in the degree.



Remarks	Practical information regarding course selection at Politecnico di Milano: The first course you choose in your study plan decides which track "indirizzo" you will be connected to. You will be asigned to a teacher "referente" that is responsible for all incoming students within his area of expertise. This is the person that will approve your study plan and you will be able to change your study plan during your first month at Politecnico di Milano. You are allowed to choose 12 ECTS from a different school "scuola" during each semester. The study plan will automatically block you from choosing more than 12 ECTS from another school.

Application formalities	The courses in Architecture are given in both English and Italian. There are only 5 seats available for exchange students for each course taught in English. So the first students to sign up for the course gets the seats. However, since the courses are very practical it is possible to attend the Italian course without previous Italian knowledge. The teachers are used to having exchange student that doesn't speak Italian and are able to give the students special conditions like presenting in English etc.


Many of the universities offer courses in English and in the official language of the country (French, German, Spanish etc.) Please investigate on the website of the university about this!



Plan your studies

- Important to have a study plan (the courses that you will take abroad should be credited in your education here at Chalmers)
- Talk to your director of studies!



Application – when and how?

January 15 – February 15

Online through a system called MoveOn

- Create an account
- You can select two options
- Fill out the application and attach a motivation letter
- Submit your application before deadline
- Students within architecture should attach a portfolio



Recevied a spot or not?

- You will get an email if you have received a spot
- You need to accept or reject the offer
- Students who receive their first option will be noticed first
- If you do not receive your first or second option you can select from the spots that have not been allocated

Nomination and application

- Nomination
- Instructions directly from the partner university
- Normally, you need to send an application to the partner university
 - CV
 - Motivation letter
 - Transcript of records etc.





(If possible) apply for CSN – Studies abroad

The Erasmus Grant:

Approx. 315 euro / 420 euro

70% in the beginning

30% after

You need to fill out and send all the requsted document to CIM

At the partner university

Accommodation – assistance from the partner university can vary

Language course – a good start of the exchange

Welcome Day / Welcome Week – meet other students and often very fun

Important

You need to plan your exchange Seek information regarding visa Is it possible for you to rent your appartment?

If you are receiving a scholarship, please check if it is possible for you to go on exchange

Can be a little bit challenging administratively but it is worth it!
