

Rules for the Laser Lab

The following rules are for the protection of both the equipment and you as a user. It is also to make it smooth and easy for all the users of the Laser lab to share the facility.

- You are only allowed to use the Laser Lab if you have completed the **Operation License workshop**.
- In the laser cutter, you are **ONLY** allowed to use materials that we have purchased and put in the Laser Lab.
- You are not allowed to laser cut **reflective** materials such as metals or mirrors, or PVC plastic.
- **You MUST stay** with the laser cutter during the whole cutting process, being aware of any flames that appear and stay for more than a couple of seconds (shut down the cutting if more flames appear).
- Do NOT put objects on top of the laser cutter.
- Do NOT leave the laser cutter door panel open.
- Always follow the safety instructions written on the laser cutter.
- You are allowed to use the 3d printer for private projects, but if you print objects larger than 50 grams, please discuss with the Studio Manager or Studio Director.
- When you are done with your cut or print, you must **turn off** the machine you used.
- If you do 3d prints overnight, make sure to retrieve your print the morning after and turn off the machine if you're done.
- When you are done with the computer for the day, please **shut down** all applications, including web browser. The only application allowed to stay open overnight is application needed for any overnight print.

Finally, always make sure to **clean up** after yourself, including left over material, failed prints and cuts, sketches and coffee mugs.
